Personal History

Arthur Erenst MERVIN was born at Liverpool, Lancashire in 1897 the son of Richard Nimrod and Maud Gladys MERVIN nee LITTLE who were married 15/05/1893 at Everton, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died in 1911. His mother died in 1911.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 18, St. Mary's Lane, Walton. Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Drapers Shop Assistant.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 49, Elston Street, Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Liverpool (Great Howard) as a Porter

He was living at Walton. Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 26 June 1917 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal & British War Medal
