Personal History

Henry MIDDLETON was born at Hodnet, Shropshire in 1877 the son of Benjamin and Rachel MIDDLETON nee LEECH who were married 1868 at Wem Shropshire. His father died in 1910. His mother died in 1910. In the 1911 census the family were living at 24, Elizabeth Ann Street, Rochdale Road, Manchester,. He was aged 32 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1891 census the family were living at Heath Farm Hodnet, Shropshirem. He was aged 13 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Stores Dept. at Manchester Osborne as a Porter

Service History

He was living at Manchester, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Salford, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 23 November 1915. His last known address was Manchester, Rochdale Road, Elizabeth Ann Street, 24 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 12 July 1916 aged 39

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
