Personal History

Frank MILBURN was born at Bury, Lancashire on 9 July 1888 the son of George Diggle and Susannah MILBURN nee BRADSHAW who were married 1887 at St. George, Unsworth, Bury, Lancashire. His father died in 1899. His mother died in 1899.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 74, Devon Street, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 684, Manchester Road, Bury, Lancashire,. He was aged 12

In the 1891 census the family were living at Roach Mount, Heap, Heywood, Lancashire,. He was aged 2

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Bury as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Bury, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 25 September 1914. His last known address was Bury, Devon Street. 74 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 August 1915 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
