Personal History

Job MILLS was born at Radcliffe, Lancashire on 1 December 1076 the son of John and Elizabeth MILLS nee MILLWARD who were married 20/11/1875 at St. Thomas & St. John. Radcliffe, Lancashire. His mother died in 1933.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 17, Church Street, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire,. He was aged 34 with the occupation of Railway Porter.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 17, Church Street, Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire,. He was aged 24 with the occupation of Railway Porter.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendant of the Line at Portsmouth as a Collector

He was living at Poulton-le-Fylde, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Royal Army Medical Corps at Liverpool, Lancashire. on 17 August 1914 and embarked for Mesopotania on 25 January 1918. His last known address was Poulton (le-Fylde, Lancashire, Church Street, 17 - Army Records).

He is recorded as Died of disease on 30 August 1918 aged 41

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
