## Personal History

Arthur Percy MONCRIEFF was born at Liverpool. Lancashire in 1895 the son of John and Emly MONCRIEFF nee BROWN who were married 1874 at St. Silas, Toxteth Park, West Derby, Liverpool. His father died in 1914. His mother died in 1914.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 27, Weldon Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Telegraph Messenger.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 37, York Street, Walton, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Shunter

## Service History

He was living at Liverpool. Lancashire when he enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at the same place. He is recorded as Killed in action on 30 November 1917 aged 22 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
