Harry MOON was born at Deepdale, Preston, Lancashire in 1896 the son of John and Ellen MOON nee HOOTON who were married 27/04/1893 at St. Luke, Preston, Lancashire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Goldfinch Street, Pesto, Lancashire,. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Printers Apprentice.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 55, St. Stephens Road, Preston, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Preston as a Slipman and Drainer

He enlisted in the Royal Garrison Artillery at Preston, Lancashire. He is recorded as Killed in action on 27 September 1917 aged 21 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
