Personal History

Thomas MORAN was born at Mayo, Ireland on c. 1885 the son of Michael and Mary MORAN. In the 1911 census the family were living at 43, Greasbro Road, Rotherham, Yorshire,. He was aged 26 with the occupation of Coal Miner (Hewer).

In the 1901 census the family were living at Tullagany, Urlaur, Mayo, Ireland,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Farmers Son.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Checker

Service History

He was living at Kilkelly, Co. Mayo, Ireland when he enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery at Sheffield, Yorkshire.

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 15 June 1918 aged 33

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
