Personal History

John Charles MORETON was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 27 February 1896 the son of John and Elizabeth MORETON.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 16, Lowell Street, Walton, Liverpool, Lancashire. He was aged 15 with the occupation of Bakers Assistant.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Dane Street, Walton, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Porter

Service History

He was living at 48, Claudia Street, Walton Bootle when he enlisted in the Kimgs Liverpool Regiment at Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire. on 16 November 1915 and embarked for France on 17 June 1916. His last known address was Walton, Liverpool, Lowell Street, 16 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 26 September 1916 aged 20

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
