Personal History

Harold MORRILL was born at Goole, Yorkshire on 24 June 1889 the son of William and Mary Ellen MORRILL nee VARLEY who were married 06/04/1881 at Goole. His father died in 1932. His mother died in 1932.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 8. Queensway, Goole, Yorkshire,. He was aged 21 with the occupation of Dock Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 2, Forth Street, Goole. Yorkshire,. He was aged 12

In the 1891 census the family were living at 67, Gordon Street, Goole.. He was aged 1

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ada Margaret MORRILL (nee SMITH) They married at (Place unknown) on 28 March 1905. They had children: Frank b.1915

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Goole as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry at Goole, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 11 September 1915. His last known address was Goole Old, Grove Cottages, 27 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 July 1916 aged 27

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
