Personal History

Robert MORRISON was born at Huddersfield, Yorkshire on 18 August 1896 the son of William and Mary MORRISON nee MORRISON who were married 07/12/1885 at St. Jude, Hunslet, Yorkshire. His father died in 1936. His mother died in 1936.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 19, Parkgate, Berry Brow, Huddersfield, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Oiler in Worsteds Dept..

In the 1901 census the family were living at 21, Albert Yard, Hunslet, Yorkshire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Lines Dept. at Berry Brow as a Porter

Service History

He enlisted in the West Ridings Regiment at Huddersfield, Yorkshire. and embarked for France on 15 July 1915. His last known address was Huddersfield, Yorkshire, Berry Brow, Parkgate, 19 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Drowned on 17 November 1915 in H.S. Anglia Hospital Ship-Mined aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
