Personal History

James MOSS was born at Bethnal Green, London in 1882 the son of James MOSS.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Ellen MOSS (nee MOSS) They married at Dover on 22 March 1905. They had children: Ellen Ethel b.1911

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Manchester (Victoria) as a Plate Layer

Service History

He enlisted in the Royal West Kent Regiment at Stratford, London. and embarked for France on 15 August 1914. His last known address was 9, Albion Place, Dover, Kent (CWGC (family)).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 September 1914 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 14 Star and Clasp
