Personal History

Maurice Edgar MOSS was born at West Kirby, Cheshire in 1895 the son of Arthur and Catherine MOSS nee HASSALL who were married 23/08/1885 at St. Bridget, West Kirby, Cheshire. His father died in 1951. His mother died in 1951.

In the 1911 census the family were living at The School House, School Lane, West Kirby, Liverpool,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Scholar.

In the 1901 census the family were living at Shool Lane , West Kirby. He was aged 6

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment. and embarked for France on 24 February 1915. His last known address was West Kirby, Liverpool, School Lane, The School House (1911 Cennsus).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 29 November 1916 aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
