Personal History

Thomas Patrick MOUNTAIN was born at Dover, Kent in 1884 the son of Patrick and Bridget MOUNTAIN nee MALLON who were married 1872 at Old Fylde Register Office or Registrar Attended . His father died in 1928. His mother died in 1928.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 22, Seymour Street, Fleetwood,. He was aged 25 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 22, Seymour Street, Fleetwood,. He was aged 17 with the occupation of Farm Servant.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 65, Upper Preston Street, Thornton, Fleetwood,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Civil Engineers Dept. at Wyre as a Labourer

Service History

He enlisted in the King's Own Royal Lancaster Regt. at Fleetwood, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 14 February 1915. His last known address was Fleetwood, Seymour Street, 22 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 17 October 1916 aged 32

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
