Personal History

Frederick George MOUNTFORD was born at Rochdale, Lancashire in 1889 the son of Henry James and Emily MOUNTFORD nee COLLIS who were married 1881 at . His father died in 1918. His mother died in 1918.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 30, Marland Avenue, Castleton, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 22 with the occupation of Railway Labourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 176, Heywood Road,, Castleton, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 12 with the occupation of Print Works Machinist.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 76. Manchester Road, Castleton, Rochdale, Lancashire,. He was aged 3

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company as a Key Maker

He was living at Rochdale, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Kings Liverpool Regiment at the same place. He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 28 June 1918 aged 29

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
