Personal History

Alfred MUDD was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 13 April 1882 the son of Matthew and Martha MUDD nee STANLEY who were married 21/04/1879 at St. Nichloas, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died in 1924. His mother died in 1924.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Dorrington Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 29 with the occupation of Railway Carriage Cleaner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Ogden, Weint, Mount Pleasant, Liverpool,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Drapers Porter.

In the 1891 census the family were living at 39, Blundell Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 9 with the occupation of Scholar.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Jane MUDD (nee SHARROCK) They married at St. Nicholas, Liverpool, Lancashire on 1 January 1905. They had children: John b.1906, Martha b.1911

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Liverpool as a Washer

He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancasahire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 August 1916 aged 34

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
