*Killed in action 17 August 1916 aged 34*

***Personal History***

*Alfred MUDD was born at Liverpool, Lancashire on 13 April 1882 the son of Matthew and Martha MUDD nee STANLEY who were married 21/04/1879 at St. Nichloas, Liverpool, Lancashire. His father died in 1924. His mother died in 1924.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Dorrington Street, Liverpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 29 with the occupation of Railway Carriage Cleaner.*

*In the 1901 census the family were living at 1, Ogden, Weint, Mount Pleasant, Liverpool,. He was aged 19 with the occupation of Drapers Porter.*

*In the 1891 census the family were living at 39, Blundell Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 9 with the occupation of Scholar.*

*He was a married man. His wife's name was Jane MUDD (nee SHARROCK) They married at St. Nicholas, Liverpool, Lancashire on 1 January 1905. They had children: John b.1906, Martha b.1911*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Liverpool as a Washer*

***Service History***

*He was living at Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the King's Liverpool Regiment at Liverpool, Lancashire.*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 17 August 1916 aged 34*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
