***Personal History***

*James MURPHY was born at Bootle, Liverpool, Lancashire in 1875 the son of James MURPHY.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at 28, Welland Street, Liverpool,. He was aged 36 with the occupation of Railway Porter.*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Lines Dept. at Blundell Sands & Crosby as a Parcel Ptr.*

***Service History***

*He was living at Kirkdale, Liverpool, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Liverpool Regiment at Crosby, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 07/03/1915. His last known address was Liverpool, Welland Street, 28 (1911 Census).*

*He is recorded as Killed in action on 16 May 1915 aged 40*

*He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal*
