Personal History

Norman MYERS was born at Horwich, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Robert and Sarah MYERS nee FRANCE who were married 1894 at Holy Trinity, Horwich, Lancashire. His father died on .

In the 1911 census the family were living at 2, Dale Street West, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Machinist (Driller).

In the 1901 census the family were living at 22. Alexander Road, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 4 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company at Horwich as a Machinist

Service History

He was living at Horwich, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Highland Light Infantry at the same place. He is recorded as Killed in action on 15 September 1916 aged 20 He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
