Personal History

Robinson MYERS was born at Clitheroe, Lancashire in 1891 the son of John Henry and Helen MYERS nee WESTRELL who were married 1886 at Ribble Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at India, Private, 2nd Battalion East Lancashie Regiment,. He was aged 20

In the 1901 census the family were living at 26. De Lacy Street, Clitheroe.. He was aged 10 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. as a Clitheroe

Service History

He enlisted in the East Lancashire Regiment at Clitheroe, Lancashire. and embarked for France on 5 September 1915. His last known address was Clitheroe, Shaw Bridgem 38 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 14 September 1916 aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
