*Lawrence NEVIN was born at Gorton, Manchester on 20 September 1894 the son of William and Kate NEVIN nee CARLAW who were married 1885 at Chorlton-on-Medlock Register Office or Registrar Attended. His father died in 1894. His mother died in 1894.*

*In the 1911 census the family were living at Buckley hall, Rochdale. Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Printers Apprentice, Cath. Boys Sch..*

*Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Carriage and Wagon Dept. at Red Bank as a Lifters Assistant*

***Service History***

*He enlisted in the Royal Marines Light Infantry. on 21 February 1915*

*He is recorded as Died of Wounds on 28 December 1915 aged 21*
