## Personal History

Thomas NEWBY was born at Barrow in Furness, Lancashire in 1889 the son of William H. and Minnie NEWBY nee MANN who were married 1886 at St. James, Barrow in Furness, Lancashire. His father died in 1948. His mother died in 1948.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 121, Junction Street, Newton Heath, Manchester, Lancs.,. He was aged 20. Railway Porter

In the 1901 census the family were living at 290, Glen Dhorn Street, Salford, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 108, Cavendish Street, Barrow in Furness, Lancashire,. He was aged 5 Months

He was a married man. His wife's name was Isabella Gertrude NEWBY (nee MALLARD) They married at Albert Mem. Church, Miles Platting, Manchester on 25 March 1905. They had children: Dorothy b.1912, Robert b. 1914

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Superintendent of the Lines Dept. at Salford as a Porter

## Service History

He was living at Newton Heath, Manchester when he enlisted in the Manchester Regiment at Manchester, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 14 July 1915. His last known address was Miles Platting, Manchester, Lansdowne Road, 12 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
