Personal History

Arthur William NEWTH was born at Moston, Manchester, Lancashire in 1896 the son of Willian John and Mary Hannah NEWTH nee HADWIN who were married 1895 at St. Philip, Manchester. His father died in 1957. His mother died in 1957.

In the 1911 census the family were living at 42, Moston Lane, New Moston, Manchester,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Railway Clerk.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 12, Belgrave Road, Moston, Manchester, Lancashire,. He was aged 4

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Hollinwood as a Clerk

Service History

He enlisted in the Kings Royal Rifles at Hollinwood, Lancashire. on 29 May 1915 and embarked for France on 1 October 1915. His last known address was New Moston, Manchester, Parkfield Road, 72 (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 19 March 1916 aged 19

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
