Personal History

Robert NORCROSS was born at Dilworth, Lancashire in 1891 the son of Obidiah and Ann NORCROSS nee MOULDING who were married 05/02/1877 at St. Lawrence, Longridge, Lancashire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 32, Prkinson Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 20 with the occupation of Cotton Spinner.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 42A, Cannon Street, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 10 In the 1891 census the family were living at 7, Bottoms, Dilworth, Lancashire,. He was aged 2 Months Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Packing Maker

Service History

He enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at Bolton, Lancashire. and embarked for Balkans on 15 June 1915. His last known address was Bolton, Parkinson Street, 32 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 9 August 1915 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
