Personal History

James ORMOND was born at Blackpool, Lancashire in 1893 the son of James and Ellen ORMOND nee BRADSHAW who were married 11/02/1888 at St. Chad, Poulton le Fylde, Lancashire. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at Raikes Farm, Thornton-le-Fylde, Lancashire,. He was aged 18 with the occupation of Farm Lanourer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 19, Camden Road, Blackpool, Lancashire,. He was aged 8 with the occupation of Scholar.

Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Chief Goods Managers Dept. at Blackpool as an Extra Carter

He enlisted in the Kings Own Royal Lancaster Regiment at Blackpool, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Died at home on 4 August 1918 in Adelaide Street Hosp., Blackpool aged 25

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
