Personal History

Ernest OULDCOTT was born at Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire in 1895 the son of Enoch and Pamela Mansfield OULDCOTT nee FARR who were married 1890 at Holy Trinity. Horwich. His mother died in 1946. In the 1911 census the family were living at 23, Gouch Street, Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Railway Puller Up Forge.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 8, Smeaton Street, Horwich, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Helper

Service History

He was living at Horwich, Bolton, Lancashire when he enlisted in the Loyal North Lancashire Regiment at the same place. on 3 August 1914 and embarked for France on 4 May 1915. His last known address was Horwich, Bolton Gouch Street, 23 (1911 Census).

He is recorded as Killed in action aged 21

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
