Personal History

George Henry PAGE was born at Woburn Sands, Bedfordshire in 1887 the son of Alfred and Sarah Fanny PAGE nee RAYNOR who were married 13/09/1886 at Woburn Sands, Bedfordshire. His father died in 1946. His mother died in 1946.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 25, Miedden Stones, Halifax, Yorkshire,. He was aged 14 with the occupation of Errand Boy at News Office.

He was a married man. His wife's name was Amy Ann PAGE (nee SCOTT HARRISON) They married at St. Luke, Norland, Halifax, Yorkshire on 22 June 1912. They had children: Irene b.1913, George Alfred b. 1915 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Sowerby Bridge as a Labourer

Service History

He was living at Sowerby Bridge, Yorkshire when he enlisted in the Hampshire Regiment at Halifax, Yorkshire. and embarked for (Theatre of war not known) on 3 October 1915. His last known address was Sowerby Bridge, Park Street (CWGC).

He is recorded as Killed in action on 7 December 1915 aged 28

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal & 1914-15 Star
