Gavin PARKER was born at Lostock, Bolton, Lancashire in 1894 the son of Gavin and Alice PARKER nee HURST who were married 1893 at St. Mary the Virgin, Deane Parish Church, Bolton. His father died on . In the 1911 census the family were living at 14, Heaton Road, Lostock, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 16 with the occupation of Cotton Piecer.

In the 1901 census the family were living at 70, Gypsy Nook, Lostock, Bolton, Lancashire,. He was aged 6 Before enlisting he was employed by the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway Company, Locomotive Dept. at Horwich as a Driller

He enlisted in the Lancashire Fusiliers at Horwich, Lancashire.

He is recorded as Killed in action on 1 June 1918 aged 24

He was awarded the Victory Medal, British War Medal
