- d. Unless you are searching for 'Smith'..... start with a surname
 - i. Narrow it down with a first name
 - ii. Use any other filters that are offered such as a date range

10. Special Page

a. Manchester / Research / Databases – because you can see the full list of databases that includes those that are not included in the orange 'search' button because they have different properties. This listing includes links to the Godfrey Maps Index, Resource Library, Strays and Members Interests.

11. Documents

- a. Accessed from the Member Area and, in some cases, also accedssible from the Branches' Research sections
- b. 'General' refers to Documents relating to every researcher
- c. 'Bolton', 'Oldham' and 'Scotland/Anglo Scottish' are separate local collections created by the branches.

12. Speakers' Notes and Videos

- a. Some speakers allow their handouts and videos to be available for public viewing, some restrict permissions to members only and time-limited
- b. To provide easy access to handouts and videos, each branch has its own access point in the branch's Research section

13. Newsletter

- a. The Society and the Branches issue newsletters most months and each section has its own link page
- b. The Manchester Newsletter is administrative and informative for all and is automatically sent to all members
